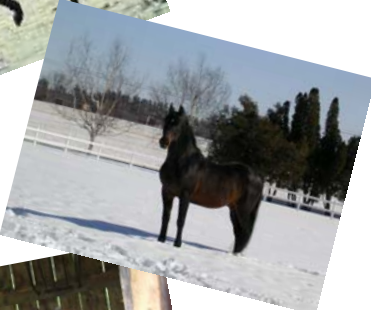
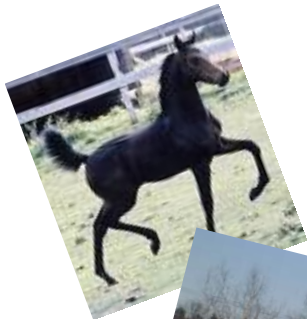

- Judging with Oral Reasons
- Horsemanship Pattern

The VMHA continues to encourage excellence in it's members by providing a memorial scholarship each year to an outstanding man or woman who would like to continue their education.
